ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore Excursions are available on a first-come, first served basis. Guests should note that some shore excursions are very popular with guests and often ending up being waitlisted. In order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate in excursions are subject to availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge Desk within the cancellation deadline. For our selected Shore Excursions Tickets returned after the cancellation deadline will be charged 100% cancellation fee to the guest's onboard account. Cancellation deadlines for the majority of our shore excursions is 48hrs prior to the port of call. Please note that certain shore excursions might have a different cancellation deadline; all cancellation deadlines are stated in the please note section of the shore excursion, booking form and shore excursion tickets.

ONLINE ADVANCE RESERVATION OF SHORE EXCURSIONS

Silversea operates an online reservation option, allowing guests to reserve their shore excursions at leisure prior to their cruise. In order to access this, please log on to MySilversea (my.silversea.com) up to 48 hours prior to your sail date. If you have reserved your shore excursion online, you will receive further information upon embarkation onboard.

SHORE EXCURSION DEPARTURES TIMES

Departure times are published in the ship's daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicles and on shore excursion tickets. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore. Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and shore excursion departures as local conditions dictate.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

You may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a shore excursion booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the shore excursions in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Shore Excursion tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

SHORE EXCURSION PRICING

Prices are generally quoted per person, per tour, with the exception of Silver Shore Privato or group-designated excursions. Prices are subject to change without notice. Please visit MySilversea (my.silversea.com) for the most up-to-date information. Please note that prices for Shore Excursions are quoted in U.S.Dollars only. Discounts for children under 12 years of age are available on some, but not all tours. Prices for children, if available, will be adjusted onboard. Please see the Shore Concierge team prior to your excursion to discuss the availability of children's pricing.

SHORE EXCURSION DEPARTURE TIMES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, shore excursion departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Departure times from the ship are published in the ship's daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicles and on shore excursion tickets. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least 10-minutes prior to the shore excursion departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pierside to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore. Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and shore excursion departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that approximate pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com).

SHORE EXCURSION SUITABILITY

Silversea offers a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. However, certain excursions are more appropriate for physically fit and active guests. All excursions offered are clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. We also offer a good variety of Accessible Shore Excursion worldwide (according to the ports availability and local structure) that are designed for guests unable to negotiate motor coach steps or for full time wheelchair/scooter users. The vehicle used on this type of shore excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of mobility devices. In order to use the ramp and/or lift, guests are required to be seated on a wheelchair or scooter. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain to select excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the excursion description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information. Silversea also offers Destination Experience Briefings onboard. If you have any questions or concerns regarding shore excursion suitability, please contact the Shore Concierge (shoreconcierge@silversea.com) prior to your cruise or visit the Shore Concierge desk for more detailed information once onboard.

ON LAND SILVER SHORE CONCIERGE SERVICES

Expert Shore Excursion professionals are available to assist guests with their destination knowledge, personalised planning and coordination of all private, independent touring suggestions. This could include area highlights, flightseeing, water sports and more. To take advantage of this service, requests should be submitted no later than 15 days prior to sailing and guests must have a deposited or fully paid their outstanding balance. There is a service fee of \$100 per voyage to secure your arrangements, however this fee will be applied to your confirmed programme in that port. ONBOARD SHORE CONCIERGE TEAM

Whether you wish to participate in an organised shore excursion or tailor-made shore excursion, Silversea's experienced Shore Concierge team are happy to assist you to plan the best shore-side experiences with knowledgeable suggestions,

personalized planning for sightseeing, water sports, golf and more. The Shore Concierge team is available onboard on sea days from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Office opening hours in port may vary whilst staff is shore-side assisting those on excursions. Please refer to the Silversea Chronicles for daily office opening hours. Once onboard, those considering a bespoke excursion should contact the Shore Concierge team at their earliest possible convenience, as time may be a factor in reaching local contacts. Please be aware that once arrangements are confirmed they are non-refundable.

DESTINATION EXPERIENCE BRIEFINGS

Throughout the voyage the Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant will offer port and shore excursion information prior to arrival in each port of call. Their aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and answer as many of your questions as possible. The information is presented in the theatre or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system, and will allow more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicles. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. Children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment. Such harnesses' and secure seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately, guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES

Please note that photography at some museums, sites and monuments and/or the use of video cameras may not be allowed or may incur a charge. These charges are not included in the tour price and are at guests' own expense. Further details will be in the detailed shore excursion description and please note section. Please ensure to review these in detail prior to departing on your shore excursion.

SHOPPING STOPS

While our organised excursions are not generally geared to the serious shopper, some shore excursions allow for short shopping stops as indicated in the shore excursion description. In the interest of all participants, guests should adhere to the allotted time and return to the tour vehicle promptly as advised by the tour guide or ship's escort. Please Note: The selection of shops is generally left to the discretion of the tour operator. Silversea does require that establishments be reputable, of general interest to our guests and offer quality goods. However, all purchases are the responsibility of the individual.

Minimal Activity

Excursions are easily paced without the need for excessive walking or physical activities. Being able to board motor coaches and negotiate steps can be encountered.



Extensive Activity

Active excursions are recommended only for those guests in good physical health, with considerable amounts of physical activity.



Moderate Activity

Full participation requires being in good physical condition and may involve inclines, steps, uneven surfaces and/or extended periods of standing.



Adventure Tour - Physically fit

Moderate Mobility Issue

MRS-A / Marseille Highlights

Difficulty

Duration: 4.00 hr(s) **INCLUDED EXCURSION**

Experience the panoramic beauty and splendour of Marseilles during this half-day sightseeing tour of France's second-largest city. Marseille is a rich, pulsing port city bubbling over with history, cutting-edge creative spaces and hip multicultural urbanites. Since Greek settlers came ashore around 600 BC, waves of immigrants have made Marseille their home.

Marseilles Tour

Depart the pier for the brief drive into downtown Marseilles. Upon arrival, your tour commences at the Old Port, or 'Vieux Port'. Once used by the Greeks, this deep cove is now occupied by the boats of fishermen and tourists. After a photo stop in front of the Town Hall, drive along the seaside road, Corniche Kennedy.

Notre-Dame de la Garde

Next, your tour proceeds to the Notre-Dame de la Garde. The landmark of Marseilles, this basilica overlooks the entire city and the Mediterranean.

You will be then back on the old port for a 30-minutes free time along the quays before returning to your ship.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking for approximately 1,640 feet (about 500 metres), at the Notre Dame de la Garde from the bus parking, there are about 100 steps to negotiate; guests with limitations or those with a wheelchair may stay on the coach during the visit to Notre Dame de la Garde. The remaining portion of this tour is suitable for those with limited mobility; however, guests must be able to embark/disembark the coach via steps. A minimum number of participants per guide are required to operate this programme.

MRS-CA / Charming Aix-en-Provence

Difficulty

Duration: 4.75 hr(s) **INCLUDED EXCURSION / OU RECOMMENDED TOUR**

Discover the historic landmarks and beauty of Aix-en-Provence on foot during this scenic and memorable walking tour through the Old City. This city is all class: its leafy boulevards and public squares are lined with 17th- and 18th-century mansions, punctuated by gurgling moss-covered fountains. Haughty stone lions guard its grandest avenue, cafe-laced cours Mirabeau, where fashionable Aixois pose on polished pavement terraces sipping espresso.

Depart the pier for the approximate 45-minute drive inland to Aix-en-Provence, which was once the capital of Provence, an independent kingdom at the time. Today, Aix is a lively university and spa town with a sophisticated atmosphere.

Aix en Provence

Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour through the romantic streets of Aix and past its stately 17th- and 18th-century mansions. Other sites to be seen include the famous Cours Mirabeau, an idyllic, tree-lined boulevard with beautiful fountains, the statues of King René of Provence and Anjou, as well as many outdoor cafés. In addition, learn about the great 19th-century master Paul Cézanne, who was born in Aix in 1839.

After a refreshment stop, some free time is made available before re-boarding the coach for the return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking for approximately 1/2 mile (800 metres), over mostly paved surfaces with a few steps to negotiate. It is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. We recommend wearing comfortable clothing, walking shoes and sun protection.

MRS-D / Villages de Provence & Olive Oil Mill Visit

Difficulty

Experience the Provençal charm of Southern France during this scenic, full-day excursion to some of the 'must see' villages of Provence - Les Baux de Provence and Saint Rémy de Provence. These two picturesque villages date back centuries; Les Baux de Provence offers a majestic hilltop location with sites of historical interest and the celebrated Cathedral of Images. Saint Rémy is embraced by a wide, leafy boulevard; the lazily charming old town is a maze of winding streets, cafés, squares and fountains with two exceptional attractions on its edge.

Depart the pier for the brief drive through the Provençal landscapes en route to the little mountain range known as the Small Alps, or 'Les Alpilles', home of incredibly scenic village of Les Baux de Provence.

Les Baux de Provence, Lunch

Upon arrival, take a guided tour of a traditional olive oil mill for a tasting of its products. After this delightful tasting, take a guided walking tour of the impressive ruins of a former 11th-century citadelle, which is perched on a rocky plateau. Some free time is then made available to explore the village and browse the many Provençal shops. Enjoy Lunch in a local restaurant before your next destination.

St. Remy de Provence

Continue your drive to Saint Rémy de Provence, which acts as a sort of link between the Arles area and the Provence of the Popes. Although it has every appearance of being no more than a prosperous farming community, this small town is inextricably linked to the unavoidable 'tourist route' through Provence. Philosopher Nostradamus was born in a house on Rue Hoche in St. Remy, only later moving to Salon de Provence to compile his famous, influential prophecies. Three centuries later a tormented Vincent Van Gogh sought refuge in St. Remy where he painted some of his best known works.

Return to the ship in Marseilles via your coach on the approximate 1-hour and 15 minute drive.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately .75 miles (1100 metres), with inclines, cobblestone streets and steps to negotiate. It is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Although a minimum number of participants are required for tour's operation, space is very limited. We recommend wearing comfortable clothing, walking shoes and sun protection. The order of the sites visited may vary.

MRS-E / Avignon & Chateauneuf du Pape

Difficulty

Soak up the essence of French culture, history and cuisine on this delightful full-day excursion in the Southern Rhone Valley. Enjoy a wine tasting at Châteauneuf-du-Pape, a delicious and refined lunch, and a walking tour of Avignon.

Tasting at the Illustrious Châteauneuf-du-Pape region

Make a scenic 90-minute drive to Châteauneuf-du-Pape's legendary vineyards. Established by the Archbishop of Bordeaux in the early 14th century, Châteauneuf-du-Pape translates to "the Pope's new castle" in reference to the Pope relocating the papacy to this region in Avignon. Today, Châteauneuf-du-Pape is one of the most productive regions, with 110,000 hectolitres of wine produced annually in a region encompassing nearly 8,000 acres.

Located in the heart of the Châteauneuf du Pape AOC, the Château des Fines Roches cellars welcome you in a historic setting and invite you to taste the family-produced wines.

As independent winemakers and producers of the Châteauneuf du Pape AOC, Domaines Mousset offers you the opportunity to taste our family-produced AOC Châteauneuf du Pape white and red cuvées.

Our tasting room is a warm and friendly place, reflecting the estate and its wines. Housed in part of the former cellars of Château des Fines Roches, in the heart of the Châteauneuf du Pape appellation, it is an ideal place to discover our wines, whether our traditional or single-varietal cuvées.

Once greeted at the entrance of the estate, proceed to the Caveau for the entire explanation and tasting session of 3 wines.

Avignon, Lunch, Walking Tour, Popes' Palace

After 30-minute drive, arrive in Avignon and enjoy your lunch before discovering its history on foot on an approximate 90-minute guided walking tour. Discover the Catholic roots of this city, founded by Pope Clement in the early 14th century and maintained with papal rule until 1791, when it officially became part of France. See the famous Pont d'Avignon of the French nursery rhyme and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Your knowledgeable guide helps you discover the manifold charms of Avignon, with its spectacular architecture and views that make it the heart of Provence's culture and history. See for yourself how the city is centered around the largest Gothic palace in Europe, the Palais des Papes (UNESCO). Avignon's medieval architecture and stature as a destination for art and culture was established with the transfer of the papacy in the 14th century. At this time lavish sums were spent on creating the papal palace and other religious architecture. Enjoy some free time before rejoining the coach for the journey back to Marseilles.

Please note: This tour involves a significant amount of activity, including over 1.6km of walking (often over cobblestone surfaces) and at least 50 steps, making this tour not suitable for guests with walking difficulties or for those in wheelchairs. Guests must be able to board and exit the coach on their own. Cameras and video are prohibited at the Pope's Palace. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable clothing and expect some sun exposure. At Domaines de Mousset, vineyards and actual cellars are not visited. The whole explanation and visit is done in the Caveau Room. Space on this tour is limited; we suggest you book well in advance to avoid disappointment.

MRS-J / Chateau La Coste: Art & Architecture

Experience a uniquely beautiful blend of vineyards, art and architecture during this half-day excursion to the Château La Coste Estate.

Marseilles, Château La Coste Estate

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately one-hour drive to the Château La Coste Estate, located north of Aix-en-Provence. Château La Coste combines all the elements of the perfect French 'art de vivre', a unique artistic experience in an atmosphere of calm luxury. Depending on your predilection, Château la Coste is either an estimable winemaker with a sideline in contemporary art, or a marvel of modern architecture with an open-air gallery that happens to have a vineyard attached. Whatever your viewpoint, Château La Coste is an exceptional discovery of art, architecture and fine wine.

Guided Walking Tour, Woods, Hills, Olive Groves, Vineyards

Château La Coste is an atypical art estate in a protected environment. Before creating their works, contributing artists and architects were invited to visit the estate and discover the beauty of its landscapes. Afterward, freedom was given to them as to the choice the work created, and the location in which it would be placed. The estate continues to grow, with many upcoming installations planned. Upon arrival, take a guided exterior walking tour of the estate. Along the way, stroll through the woods, hills, olive groves, and vineyards of the estate, and discover the works of art and installations of the contemporary artists and architects invited.

Art Installations, Architectural Creations, Oak & Pine Trees, Vines, Lavender Fields

Over 30 major art installations are scattered throughout the domain amongst oak trees, 100-year-old pines, vines, and lavender fields. Marvel at architectural creations by Tadao Ando, Jean Nouvel, Renzo Piano and Frank O. Gehry, as well as art installations created by renowned artists and luminaries. Included are: Louise Bourgeois, Alexander Calder, Larry Neufeld, Ai Weiwei, Sean Scully, Andy Goldsworthy, Michael Stipe, Tom Shannon, Tracey Emin, and Liam Gillick. Following your guided tour, enjoy some free time for independent exploration. Your tour concludes with an approximately one-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for up to 0.93 miles (about 1.5 kilometres), at times over uneven, natural, and cobblestone surfaces and inclines, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and steps at the estate. Walking at the Château La Coste Estate is at the discretion of each guest. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection, a sweater or light jacket, an umbrella, bottled water, and bring Euros and/or credit cards for purchases from the ship. Guests must be at least 12 years old to participate on this tour. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is very limited; we suggest you book in advance to avoid disappointment.

MRS-L / S.A.L.T. A Day in the Life: Gorgeous Seasonal Lunch in Chef Paul's 17th Century Provençal Farmhouse

Join chef Paul Griffon, co-owner of one of Marseilles' hottest bistrots, for a multi-course seasonal lunch in his family's spectacular 17th century farmhouse. Discover the essence, bounty and beauty of the Provençal table: from seasonal aromatics and organic vegetables sourced directly from the family garden to the estate's select extra virgin olive oil and locally made honey. Learn the building blocks of the Provençal kitchen alongside Chef Paul and Maddalena, from Provençal classics like anchoïades and fenouillades to ratatouille and almande croquant. Warm and welcoming, Paul spent 3 years in a Michelin Starrestaurant; as your principal guide, gastronome and food expert Maddalena shares colorful anecdotes and deep food knowledge. Set among centuries-old olive groves in a pristine country setting, lunch includes local wines & cheeses, homemade jams & olive oil, starters, main course and dessert, as well as a few "bubbly" surprises throughout.

Provençal Village of Lourmarin, Walking tour, Bread & Cheese Sample

Meet one of your hosts at the pier and start the 55-minute drive to the village of Lourmarin, considered among the most picturesque in all Provence, for an introduction to village life, the principles of seasonal Provençal cuisine, and a guided walk through the village. Paul's family farmhouse is a 10-minute drive from Lourmarin, tucked in an idyllic Mediterranean countryside.

Chef and Michelin Star Sommelier Paul Griffon, Family's 17th Century Provençal Farmhouse, Lunch & Wines

The chef's story starts in his home city of Paris, and his annual journeys south to spend summers at his grandfather's farm. Charismatic and creative, Paul relishes in his family history and his country's culinary heritage, and today hosts events all over the south of France with the help of his mother and wife.

Guests learn Provençal classics, from anchoïades and fenouillades to ratatouille and almond croquant.

With insight and joy, Paul shares his passion for Provençal food and community, and always joins his guests around the table.

Activities may include:

- Making traditional Provençal tapenades and local fenouilledes --> fennel seed, crushed vegetables, olive oil, almonds, black olives, capers, fennel, red wine vinegar. Guests chop, mortar and pestle, taste & create their own versions with guidance using anchovies, basil and chilis, served on local breads.
- Taste the extra virgin olive oils they produce on the farm, understanding artisan production technique and exploring flavor profiles with food pairings.
- Slice a selection of local charcuterie --> rosette (local saucisson); coppa from nearby Alps; assorted charcuterie from small producers in the Luberon.

Lunch will include seasonal salads, vegetables, meat, fish, cheese, dessert, wines and coffee. All will be served buffet style and in relaxed way. You will be part of the Family and maybe help opening wines, preparing the table or sourcing fresh aromatics.

Your Hosts: Paul Griffon & Maddalena Relli

Paul worked for 3 years as sommelier at Michelin star Simpsons Restaurant in the UK before receiving an advanced degree from the University of Gastronomic Sciences in Bra (Piedmont, Italy). Upon returning to his native France he opened Copains in the heart of Marseilles' Old Town. When not in Marseilles he can be found cooking with his mother and wife in their 400-year-old family farm.

Maddalena is a gastronome in every sense of the word. An eco-farm (owned by a family who's been in Portofino for generations) on a mission to revitalize local agricultural practices with contemporary tools, working on clean energy production and deep mountain water extraction. This is a once in a lifetime adventure, beginning with the 10-15 minutes drive through the woods of the Portofino natural reserve on special porters, the only vehicles allowed on this private road, which twists and turns taking you higher and higher, past secluded cottages (the high-profile residents value their privacy) and secret gardens, up where only few lucky ones can go.

Meet the Owners, Short Trek (5 minutes), Welcome refreshment

Anyone can go to the *piazzetta* down below. But only those with a special permit can rise above it. Once on top of the mountain, the second part of this unforgettable experience begins. Greeted by La Portofinese's co-owner, you will take a short walk (5 minutes) to the entrance of the farm. All guests typically stop here to enjoy the jaw-dropping view; it's hard to describe it, so take our word for it: you will want to pause, and take it in. You will then proceed to your exclusive short cooking demo + tasting session, enjoying a welcoming refreshment: the farm's own Vermentino, crisp and vibrant, made with the grapes from the historic vineyards that grip to the farm's slopes and bathe in sun and sea breeze; or the farm's special nonalcoholic beverages, all made with local ingredients: *limonata*, *aranciata*, *gazzosa* and *tè freddo*.

Focaccia Demo & Tasting, Pic nic with a View

Now it's focaccia time with La Portofinese's chef (who is also in charge of the farm's osteria): not only will he teach you how to make the famously delicious focaccia ligure and the cheese-oozing focaccia di Recco, but he will also bake a fresh batch of each in the farm's wood fired oven. Steal a bite before you head to the top of the farm's property for a picnic with a view, at the Portofinese's highest table, nestled between vineyards and stone pines. If you look closely, you'll spot the farm's beehives: their honey is so in demand it's also featured for breakfast at the Splendido Belmond Hotel, in Portofino. You will taste it too, as part of your picnic: together with the farm's own lemon jam it will accompany a selection of fresh cheese; you will also enjoy the still warm focaccia, plus a selection of bruschette and farm to table vegetable pies, fresh fruit, cake or crostata, with the farm's own extra virgin olive oil. Beverages will include the farm's own wine, beer (golden and amber ale) and sodas.

Relax or Visit the Farm, Coffee & Liquors

After lunch it's time to decide whether you'll want to sit back and relax, bathing in the sun, or walk with the farm's guide among the vineyards and the olive groves, learning about La Portofinese's agricultural practices and philosophy: to recover abandoned lands, promoting a return to agriculture and animal husbandry that used to be the backbone of the area. Over the years the owners' family, which also owns a restored mill and manages the famous Portofino lighthouse, recovered and restored to production many olive groves and vineyards. Want some coffee? Begin with the 10-15 minutes drive through the woods of the Portofino natural reserve on special porters, the only vehicles allowed on this private road, which twists and turns taking you higher and higher, past secluded cottages (the high-profile residents value their privacy) and secret gardens, up where only few lucky ones can go.

Osteria "I Coppelli"

You will arrive at the Osteria "I Coppelli", that rises from the ancient walls of a drying room used in the past to dehydrate chestnuts, corn on the cob and other products collected from the Portofino hill sides. The owners decided to transform it while still keeping its main identity and characteristics. The Osteria is now equipped with an ecologically-sustainable system which will become energy self-sufficient quite soon, all the while fully respecting the environment.

Inside the Osteria there is an olive oil press mill and the cold crusher ensures the success of the most delicate phase of the entire process when producing the extra virgin olive oil. There is also a multifunctional laboratory for the processing and production of the local products, like the honey and the beer. Surrounding the building there are a beautiful olive grove integrated with young olive trees, where their poultry ranges free, and an aromatic garden where the basil for the pesto grows.

Cooking Experience: Corzetti Pasta & Pesto Sauce, Lunch with a View

In your Cooking Experience you will learn how to make the fresh Pasta "Corzetti" and the Pesto.

The "Corzetti" are one of the oldest kinds of pasta, which is part of the Genoese and Liguria tradition since medieval ages. The Corzetti, or Croxetti, are small circles of pasta with a flowery decoration stamped on them. It is said that originally the stamp was done by pressing a coin on the pasta. Only afterwards this edible art developed and the pasta makers started to use elaborate wood stamps, especially done for embossing any kind of design or noble family coat arm. Today you can find Italian Corzetti already prepared and packed in regional food shops or in few typical restaurants. Making them at home is quite unusual, it takes time and finding corzetti stamps is not that easy.

However, there are still few artisan woodcarvers, especially in the East Italian Riviera, who work to preserve this ancient art and carves gorgeous garnishing stamps just like centuries ago.

After making the pasta, you will prepare the Pesto, the most famous Italian sauce, typical from Liguria, made with basil, garlic, cheese, olive oil and pine nuts.

At the end of the cooking class, you will enjoy a lunch where you will taste the Corzetti with the Pesto and some other tasty local products from the farm's own land and kitchen.

After lunch, you will go back to the piazzetta in Portofino by Porter Van.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of activity, including approximately 1.5 km of walking over uneven and natural ground, inclines and approximately 30 steps, making this tour less suitable for guests with walking difficulties and not accessible for those in wheelchairs. Portofino, Church of San Giorgio

A very pleasant walk heads up to the right as you face the harbour: here you'll find a very attractive walking path through one of the largest concentrations of flora and fauna in the Mediterranean for views of the entire bay and the Tigullian Gulf. From here proceed by foot up the hill to the Church of San Giorgio. The Shrine was built in Romanesque style in 1154. During the Second World War the church was completely destroyed by a bomb dropped by a fighter-bomber. In 1950, the church was restored keeping the original structure in mind.

This small church, sitting on a ridge above Portofino, is said to contain the relics of its namesake, brought back from the Holy Land by the Crusaders. Portofino enthusiastically celebrates St. George's Day every April 23.

Faro Lighthouse

Pristine views can be had from the deteriorating Faro (lighthouse) at Punta Portofino, a 15-minute walk along the point that begins at the southern end of the port. The lighthouse was built in 1917 and is attached to a 2 storey light keeper's house. The lighthouse is completely automated, powered by a solar unit and is still operational.

Along the seaside path you can see numerous impressive, sprawling private residences behind high iron gates.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking of approximately 4km over cobblestone surfaces and steep. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or guests who utilise a wheelchair. We recommend guests wear comfortable clothing and walking shoes as well as bring sun protection.

Rapallo Village, Culinary Experience

Liguria is home to some of Italy's most iconic foods and no one is more passionate about pasta, pesto, focaccia and other local products than your local host Guido. Join him on today's tour behind the gastronomic scenes of lovely Rapallo. With its bright-blue changing cabins, palm-fringed beach and diminutive 16th century castle perched above the sea, the town has a poetic and nostalgic air. It's at its busiest on Thursdays, when market stalls fill central Piazza Cile. and and there's no one better to show you around than keen connoisseur, master chef and all-around charmer Guido!

Meet him at one of the city's most unique monuments, the Musical Kiosk with its fanciful fresco, before continuing on to Rapallo's vibrant food market to explore the produce and herbs that feature in Ligurian recipes.

The tour continues to a nearby artisanal pasta factory, where a local chef makes traditional stuffed pasta called pansoto with market-fresh herbs. Next it's time for some street food - Guido introduces you to his favorite focaccia baker serving this cheesy, decadent treat hot from the oven with a glass of local Vermentino wine. The final stop will be to Guido's own bottega. Here, you'll have the chance to make pesto alla Genovese. Pandolce is also on the menu; enjoy this traditional Christmas cake containing raisins, nuts and sundried raisins with a sweet Moscato from nearby Portofino.

A 30 minute drive will return you to Portofino.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking of approximately 0.65 miles (1.0 Km) over cobblestone surfaces and steep alley. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or guests who utilise a wheelchair. We recommend guests wear comfortable clothing and walking shoes as well as bring sun protection. regulations, consider walking 0.12 to 0.31 miles (200-500 metres) from the Tender Pier to the bus and vice versa over cobblestone surfaces, steep alleys. PTF-L / Kayak Experience in the Tigullian Bay

You will meet your tour leader at the tender pier and you will walk for approximately 1.5 km to Niasca bay where the kayak experience will begin. This tour will make you explore the beauty of the Tigullian Bay by kayak. Guided by marine biologists and local experts in off-track excursion, the staff assures not only the best company and highest quality of sea sport instruction and guiding, but the chance to come in contact with the most peculiar and traditional aspects of this small and rich natural sanctuary and its costumes. Guides of the Marine Protected Area will bring you in an ecological tour to discover ecosystems, habitats, and wildlife.

Tigullian Bay, Paraggi gulf, Olivetta Beach, Caves

After the short 1.5 km hike, you will start from Niasca where you will be briefed on how to paddle on a kayak and then you will be ready to explore the Tigullian Bay coast, starting from Niasca and leaving the spectacular view of Paraggi Gulf behind you. You will then reach the port of Portofino and reach the "Olivetta" small beach, soared above by century-old maritime pine trees. A stretch of coast rich with caves and inlets - which are accessible only by kayak - will soon start. Here you will be able to spot a great variety of species (grey herons, cormorants and dolphins). Passing by the "Punta del Faro", the lighthouse, the panorama will change: no trace of civilization can be seen as the wild nature is finally prevails!

After you kayak experience, you will paddle back to Niasca and then walk back through the same path to Portofino.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking of approximately 3 km total and the Kayak activity, therefore it is only recommended for guests who are in good physical condition, can walk in unpaved surfaces and can swim in water too deep too stand. This tour is not suitable for pregnant guests, guest with neck and/or back problems, guests with heart and/or respiratory conditions, guests prone to seasickness, guests with limited mobility, and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Meet your hiking guide at the tender pier and from there you will begin your hike to San Fruttuoso.

Scenic Hike

This route is a very scenic and the initial stretch is a steep and strenuous climb. The departure is in Via Fondaco, the road to the parking lot at the bottom of Portofino, which goes through under the Carabinieri station.

The trail, mostly consists of dirt roads and winds through the countryside to places Vessinaro. Then hike the path on the western side of the promontory that overlooks the numerous coves below, and after 1 hour and 10 'from the start, arrive in the locality Base 0. Base 0, was a military post during World War II. From here the trail enters the woods and down a steep and irregular path, with large panoramic views over the village.

San Fruttuoso Abbey

On arrival in San Fruttuoso enjoy a guided tour with some free time.

The monumental San Fruttuoso Abbey comprises of the church, which is located at the end of a narrow valley. The small, two-level cloisters between the church and the Abbey feature an open area in the centre flanked by the monks' cemetery to the

east, the tombs of the Doria family to the west and the Gothic Abbey facing towards the sea. The first community of devotees of the martyr from Tarragona settled in this small bay at the beginning of the 8th century, and built a church that repelled Saracen raids until the 10th century. The abbey reached its greatest splendour in the 15th century.

After the visit and some free time, you will return to Portofino by public motor boat with a short ride 30 minute ride.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking/hiking of approximately 3.75 miles (6.0 km) sometimes over cobblestone surfaces, steep natural surfaces and about 50 steps to negotiate at the Abbey in San Fruttuoso and a few steps to get off/on the boat. It goes up to 300 mt altitude and guests must cross narrow paths with no railing. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility, guests who utilise a wheelchair and guest with fear of height. The time spent at certain venues may be extended or reduced, and other brief stops may be added. We recommend guests wear comfortable clothing and non-slip walking/hiking shoes as well as bring sun protection.

LIV-007 / S.A.L.T. Fire & Grapes: an Italian Barbecue Feast with Wines on the Tuscan Hills

Fattoria Sardi, Lucca Hills, Vineyards

The hills outside Lucca provide fertile terroir for some of Italy's most coveted wines and Fattoria Sardi has quickly become a reference for the country's biodynamic and organic production. With over 40 acres cultivated with Sangiovese, Vermentino Syrah, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, harvested by hand, Sardi's production includes rosé, red and white wines full of character (there is also an exceptional sparkling Pet Nat). Nestled between the Apuan mountains and the Tyrrhenian Sea, the vines benefit from abundant sunshine, constant ventilation, and cool nights. The farm, which was founded in the 18th century and beautifully restored in 2006, is managed by a young couple. It boasts woods, olive groves, orchards, wheat and legume fields, as well as rooms for its guests and a dedicated chef's table, custom-built for one of Italy's most talented young culinary talents, Damiano Donati.

Donati, formerly of Lucca's award-winning Punto restaurant, created a full experience around fire-cooking using the best local, seasonal ingredients. He even designed 2 special barbecues, personally supervising their manufacture by local artisans, and a Georgian oven (similar to a tandoor), which he built himself.

Vineyard & Cellar Tour

You will depart from the port of Livorno with your English-speaking guide and your driver, towards the Fattoria. Here you will be greeted by the farm's staff who will introduce the farm's slow and sustainable philosophy and guide you on a tour of the vineyards and the cellar

Chef Damiano Donati

You will then meet chef Damiano Donati: his culinary philosophy is based on selecting the best ingredients and preparing them in the way that most enhances their natural flavors, while maintaining their nutritional values intact, whether it's oven baked pasta, roasts, stews or grilled vegetables and legumes cooked in clay pots, Tuscan-style. He also makes delicious sourdough bread with heirloom local wheat in the farm's own wood fired oven. Unsurprisingly he lends a hand in the estate's winemaking (though his specialty is cider).

Lunch & Wine Pairing

Donati will cook right in front of you, and together you will then enjoy an authentic Italian feast, with mixed antipasti (vegetables and legumes), pasta, fire-cooked meat and dessert, accompanied by a tasting of Fattoria Sardi's wines. Remember as you enjoy the best flavors of Tuscany, to take a deep breath, look around you and take in the arresting view. It doesn't get much better than this.

Time to start the 60-minute drive back to the Port of Livorno.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal amount of walking of approximately 100 mt over some gravel and few steps. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility and those on a wheelchair, however guests must be able to climb few steps and get on and off the vehicle independently. Start your Accessible Livorno Shore Excursion to Pisa by meeting your driver/guide at the Livorno cruise dock. Board your wheelchair accessible van, and enjoy the approximately 40-minute drive into the scenic town of Pisa.

Pisa

Since the beginning of the tourist brochure, Pisa has been known for just one thing, the Leaning Tower. However, this world-renowned landmark is but one component of the city's amazing religious core, the Campo dei Miracoli. Here, the Duomo, Baptistery and Camposanto complete an unrivalled quartet of medieval masterpieces. These and a dozen or so churches and palazzo scattered about the town belong to Pisa's 'Golden Age', which took place from the 11th to the 13th centuries when the city was still a port, and one of the maritime powers of the Mediterranean.

Campo dei Miracoli

Since it was first laid out, Pisa's ecclesiastical centre has been known as the Campo dei Miracoli, or 'Field of Miracles'. The sight of it is as stunning today as it must have been to medieval travellers. Nowhere in Italy are the key buildings of a city arrayed with such precision, and nowhere else is there so beautiful a contrast of stonework and surrounding meadow.

Leaning Tower of Pisa

Your next stop is the Leaning Tower of Pisa (outside visit only). Underneath the pavement and turf of the Campo dei Miracoli lies a platform of saturated sandy soil, whose instability accounts for the tilting of the Leaning Tower. Begun in 1173, construction of the tower subsided when it had reached just three storeys in height. Over the ensuing 180 years, a succession of architects continued to extend it upwards until it was finally completed and topped with a bell-chamber in 1350.

The Duomo

Leaving the Leaning Tower, proceed to the Duomo for an outside visit. The Duomo was built in 1064, a century before the Campanile. With its four levels of variegated colonnades and subtle interplay of dark grey marble and white stone, the Duomo is the archetype of the Pisan Romanesque style; a model often imitated but never surpassed.

The Baptistery

A visit is then made to the Baptistery. The third building of the Miracoli ensemble, the circular Baptistery is a bizarre mix; its three storeys of Romanesque arcades peak in a crest of Gothic pinnacles and its dome is shaped like the stalk of a lemon.

After some free time, rejoin your accessible Van for the 40-minute ride to Livorno.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking of about 0.7 miles and is specially designed for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilize a wheelchair or a scooter. LIV-009 / S.A.L.T. Dreamy San Miniato: Meet a Natural Wine Master and Learn Wine & Food Pairing with Emiko Davies and Marco Lami

Meet your guide at the pier and board the minibus for the 60-minute drive to reach San Miniato.
Wine Estate Fattoria Collebrunacchi

First stop will be at Fattoria Collebrunacchi. Fattoria Collebrunacchi is located on the San Miniato hills, between the provinces of Pisa and Florence. It is a family-run agricultural business that spans 60 hectares of land, of which 4 are cultivated with vineyards, 20 with arable crops, and 25 are wooded. The farm specializes in the production of local products, particularly those from the truffle-producing region.

The production of wine is the most well-known activity of Fattoria Collebrunacchi, which dates back to the 14th century and is still made today with great care and attention to detail. The land on which the farm is located is particularly fertile, at an altitude of around 180 meters above sea level. This is due to the fact that the area is characterized by deep, shaded valleys and extremely sunny ridges, along with the presence of fossils and shells from the Pliocene period, approximately three million years ago, which provide the soil with a rich supply of calcium and minerals. In fact, this part of Tuscany was submerged by the sea up to two million years ago, leaving numerous traces behind.

Garden and Country House Tour, Wine Tasting

We will visit the garden, where you will be impressed by the building, as well as the many lemon, orange, and cypress trees. From here, you can also spot a charming little church that belongs to the property. The garden offers a view of the vineyards that belong to the farm, which are scattered among the hills of San Miniato. The wine tasting will take place inside the house, which is very unique. It's an authentic country home, complete with a traditional kitchen and a fireplace. The house is furnished with antique furniture, rugs, and mounted animal heads. It's a lived-in home, filled with paintings, utensils, and various knick-knacks.

San Miniato Medieval town, Enoteca Marilu, Lunch & Wine Pairing with Emiko Davies and Marco Lami

You will reboard your minibus and head 15 minutes away into the hilltop town of San Miniato, which sits on the ancient pilgrim route, the Via Francigena, where you will have a private, exclusive three course lunch prepared by cookbook author and food writer Emiko Davies at Enoteca Marilu, the multifunctional space - a natural wine shop/bar + cooking school - Davies and husband, sommelier Marco Lami (formerly head of the wine program at legendary restaurant Cibreo, in Florence) have recently inaugurated in the heart of the town.

Marco will continue his wine lesson through the first course of the lunch, which is an antipasto platter where you will learn how to pair wine with food. This will be a rather technical experience, focusing on the deliciousness of food but also on how to match what's in the dish with what's in the glass (i.e., you will have to put both food and wine in your mouth at same time and chew together to understand if the pairing works). Marco will show this through a tasting of 4-5 food and wine elements, e.i. bubbles + fried food; tannins + proteins; nutty + truffles - we are in San Miniato after all - sweet + spicy, plus a dessert wine pairing with blue cheese. This will be followed by a pasta dish (e.g., handmade pasta like pici or ravioli, perhaps gnudi) and a dessert which will be paired with a dessert wine and a cheese.

After lunch, you will be driven back to the port of Livorno.

Livorno, Castagneto Carducci Village Centre, Palazzo Comunale, Via Marconi

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately one-hour drive to Castagneto Carducci, one of the most popular villages on the Etruscan Coast of Tuscany. Perched on a hillside less than 6.2 miles (about ten kilometres) from the sea, the village centre of Castagneto has grown around the imposing medieval castle located on the hilltop. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of this charming old village, a peaceful holiday destination that comes very much alive during the summer months. Along the way, see the imposing Palazzo Comunale, with its dominant position at the beginning of Via Marconi, a long street that makes its way downhill towards the coast. The Palazzo Comunale houses the city's Town Hall, and its offices.

Castagneto Castle and Gates, Cobblestone Streets, Village

Next, a very pretty lane leads you to the 10th-century Castagneto Castle, where you are escorted on an exclusive guided tour of the period rooms and family portrait gallery. See the spectacular view from the original rampart walk running between two lovely, enclosed gardens. Castagneto Carducci today is a lived-in castle and private mansion that is not typically open to the public. It has belonged to the same noble family of the Counts della Gherardesca for 32 generations, where the siblings of the current generation come to spend their summer holidays and reside during the year. Walk through the gates of the castle to enter the small cobblestone streets of the picturesque village, observe the local country lifestyle and enjoy many wonderful, unique and exclusive photo opportunities.

Guided Castle Tour, Family Portraits, Period Furnishings, Maps, Coat-of-Arms

Next, take a guided tour of the Castagneto Castle. The modern use of this imposing castle hasn't erased its history, which lives through the family portraits, period furnishings, maps and family trees with the most pedigreed Italian lineages intertwined. The coat-of-arms itself, the Half-Imperial Eagle, granted by Frederick I Holy Roman Emperor, embodies the major characteristics of the dynasty. The colour red evokes the heraldic copper and enemies' blood, and the colour gold symbolizes the land, fortified castles and property of the family that defended Tuscany from the coastal invasions of Moors and Saracens. All of this speaks the language of the eldest spirit of the Tuscan art of war.

Refreshment, Free Time, Castagneto Carducci Village

Following your castle tour, proceed for a refreshment including Prosecco, Juices and Canapes that will be served in the garden or in one of the state rooms.

Afterwards, some free time is made available to explore the village of Castagneto Carducci with his charming alleyways. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 60-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.6 miles (about one kilometre), at times over uneven and gravel surfaces and inclines, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and several steps inside the Castle. Walking at Castagneto Carducci Village is at the discretion of each guest. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection, bottled water and local currency for purchases from the ship. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is extremely limited; we suggest you book well in advance to avoid disappointment. Photos and videos are forbidden inside the Castle, it is only possible in the external areas.

Discover the exquisite beauty, art and architecture of Florence during a full-day tour of this historic city, along with some time for independent shopping and exploration.

Florence is the Italian city most celebrated by artists and poets. Each street, palace and building is living evidence of its glorious past and proud people.

Depart the pier in Livorno via coach for the approximate two-hour drive to Florence, with a comfort stop made en route. Upon arrival, meet your guide and commence your walking tour of the city.

Upon arrival in Florence, your escort will accompany you from the parking lot to meet your tour guide for a guided walk of the city.

Ponte Vecchio

Your guided tour includes Ponte Vecchio, also known as the 'Old Bridge'. Ponte Vecchio dates back to 1345 and is the only bridge in Florence to escape being blown up during World War II. It originally housed the workshops of the butchers before they were driven away by the Grand Duke, Ferdinando I, due to the terrible noise and stench they created. Ponte Vecchio was subsequently used as a workplace for goldsmiths and silversmiths; their shops still remain here to this day.

Piazza della Signoria

Located closed by Ponte Vecchio, Piazza della Signoria is Florence's second major piazza, and the political centre of the city because of its Town Hall, or 'Palazzo Vecchio'. The Piazza della Signoria is also known as an open-air museum thanks to its many statues, which include Cellini's Perseus, Giambologna's The Rape of the Sabine Women, Ammannati's Neptune Fountain and a replica of Michelangelo's famous David.

Piazza del Duomo

Your next visit will be Piazza del Duomo with an external visit of St. Mary of the Flower Cathedral. The church is adorned with an impressive façade decorated in white, green and pink Tuscan marble. Highlights to be seen during your visit include the Bell Tower, designed in 1334 by Giotto, and the Baptistery. Its celebrated doors, known as the 'Gates of Paradise', were commissioned in 1401 and designed by Lorenzo Ghiberti.

Piazza della Repubblica

The final stop on your guided tour is Piazza della Repubblica is one of the most important and iconic squares in Florence, not just for its elegant appearance today, but for its rich historical layers. The square marks the site of the ancient Roman forum, the original center of Roman Florence (Florentia), where politics, religion, and commerce converged. Over the centuries, the area became densely built-up with medieval buildings and alleys, until it was radically transformed in the late 19th century, during Florence's brief time as capital of the Kingdom of Italy (1865\1871). As part of a massive urban renewal, older structures were demolished to create a grand, modern square, a controversial decision at the time.

Following your guided tour, ample time is made available for lunch on your own and shopping.

At the conclusion of your visit, walk back to the parking lot, then re-board your coach for the 1.5-hour return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 3.4 miles (about 5.5 kilometers), some of which is over cobblestone streets. It is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. This visit represents an ideal tour for visitors who have been to Florence before, or feel independent enough to explore the city without the help of a local guide.

Florence

Upon arrival in Florence, you are dropped off at the parking lot and from here, together with your escort, walk to all the main highlights of Florence are within walking distance.

Florence is a city of many layers, at once an overrun tourist magnet and a living, breathing Medieval city that is home to proud Florentines. The stomping ground of Michelangelo, Leonardo Da Vinci, Dante and Machiavelli, among others, Florence and its cultural importance cannot be overstated. It is home to three of the world's most renowned museums, the Uffizi, Galleria dell'Accademia and the Bargello, and boasts an incredible number of important churches that house equally-important master works.

A walker's city, the centre of Florence is a compact labyrinth of alleys and piazzas. During your visit, the Ponte Vecchio, Boboli Gardens, Pitti Palace and the Duomo are but a few of the many exquisite sights the city has to offer.

Following your day in Florence on your own please return to your appointed meeting-point and time for the approximate 1.5-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires from a moderate to extensive amount of walking and is not suitable for guest with limited mobility. The coach is not permitted to drop guests into the city centre and a walk of about 30-minutes between the coach park and town is necessary. Explore the fascinating streets and squares of Lucca during a scenic and memorable half-day tour of this historic medieval city. Lucca endears itself to everyone who visits, hidden behind imposing Renaissance walls with cobbled streets, handsome piazzas and shady promenades; it makes for a perfect destination to explore by foot.

Depart the pier for the approximate 45-minute drive to Lucca. Upon arrival, your tour begins inside the massive red bricks walls, which were built between 1504 and 1645, and are amongst the best-preserved Renaissance defenses in Europe.

Lucca

Lucca is enclosed by massive red brick walls, which help to give the city its special character by shutting out traffic and the modern world. Within these walls, Lucca is a peaceful city of narrow lanes, preserving intact its ancient Roman street plan. Unlike several other Tuscany's cities, Lucca is flat; many locals use bicycles, which impart an additional charm to the city. This memorable outing is ideal for those looking to experience a Tuscan city that is rich in history, art and architecture, but is hidden from the crowds of tourists.

Church of San Michele

Along the way, an inside visit is made to the Church of San Michele in Foro, which stands on the site of the ancient Roman Forum. It has a wonderfully-rich Pisan Romanesque façade that competes in splendour with that of St. Martin.

Guinigi Tower

Another outside visit is then made to the Guinigi Tower, one of many in Lucca that belonged to the Guinigi family, rulers of the city in the 15th century. The tower has a small roof garden, with some trees sprouting incongruously at the top.

Anfiteatro Romano

Next, proceed to the Anfiteatro Romano, formerly the ancient Roman Amphitheatre. Today, it is enclosed by medieval houses that were built up against the walls of the amphitheatre. It's perfectly-preserved shape reminds us that Lucca was founded by the Romans in 180 B.C.

Church of San Frediano

From here, continue on to the Church of San Frediano, which is adorned with a striking façade and a 13th-century mosaic (outside visit only). Inside, there is a splendid Romanesque font and beautiful frescoes. In the chapel dedicated to Santa Zita, her well-preserved body is interred.

Church of San Martino

Your next stop is the Church of San Martino (outside visit only). Lucca's extraordinary cathedral, its façade abuts incongruously on to the campanile. St. Martin is the Roman soldier depicted on the façade dividing his cloak with a sword to share with a needy beggar.

Via Fillungo

The guided portion of your visit concludes at Via Fillungo, Lucca's principal shopping street, which winds its way through the heart of the city towards the Roman Amphitheatre.

Following your walking tour re-boarding your coach for the return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking for approximately 3.5km (2.17 miles), some of which is over cobblestone surfaces, and there are steps to climb. It is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. There will be an exterior visit only should a mass be in progress at the church. Discover the beauty of Pisa during this scenic, half-day tour of the city's historic landmarks, including the world-renowned Leaning Tower of Pisa.

Since the beginning of the tourist brochure, Pisa has been known for just one thing, the Leaning Tower. However, this world-renowned landmark is but one component of the city's amazing religious core, the Campo dei Miracoli. Here, the Duomo, Baptistery and Camposanto complete an unrivalled quartet of medieval masterpieces. These and a dozen or so churches and *palazzo* scattered about the town belong to Pisa's 'Golden Age', which took place from the 11th to the 13th centuries when the city was still a port, and one of the maritime powers of the Mediterranean.

Pisa

Depart the pier for the approximate 45-minute drive to Pisa. Upon arrival at the parking area, walk to the Campo dei Miracoli and commence the guided portion of your tour.

Campo dei Miracoli

Since it was first laid out, Pisa's ecclesiastical centre has been known as the Campo dei Miracoli, or 'Field of Miracles'. The sight of it is as stunning today as it must have been to medieval travellers. Nowhere in Italy are the key buildings of a city arrayed with such precision, and nowhere else is there so beautiful a contrast of stonework and surrounding meadow.

Leaning Tower of Pisa

Your next stop is the Leaning Tower of Pisa (outside visit only). Underneath the pavement and turf of the Campo dei Miracoli lies a platform of saturated sandy soil, whose instability accounts for the tilting of the Leaning Tower. Begun in 1173, construction of the tower subsided when it had reached just three storeys in height. Over the ensuing 180 years, a succession of architects continued to extend it upwards until it was finally completed and topped with a bell-chamber in 1350. Leaving the Leaning Tower, proceed to the Duomo.

The Duomo

The Duomo was built in 1064, a century before the Campanile. With its four levels of variegated colonnades and subtle interplay of dark grey marble and white stone, the Duomo is the archetype of the Pisan Romanesque style; a model often imitated but never surpassed.

The Baptistery

A visit is then made to the Baptistery. The third building of the Miracoli ensemble, the circular Baptistery is a bizarre mix; its three storeys of Romanesque arcades peak in a crest of Gothic pinnacles and its dome is shaped like the stalk of a lemon.

Piazza dei Cavalieri

Leaving the Campo dei Miracoli, visit the Piazza dei Cavalieri. One of Pisa's most interesting sites, the Piazza dei Cavalieri is a large square that opens unexpectedly from the narrow back streets, and includes the site of the Roman Forum. The central civic square of Medieval Pisa, the Roman Forum was subsequently remodelled by Vasari and became the headquarters of the Knights of St. Stephen.

Palazzo dell'Orologio

On the western side of the square is the Renaissance-adapted Palazzo dell'Orologio. In 1208, the military leader Ugolino della Gherardesca, along his sons and grandsons, was starved to death in its tower as punishment for his alleged duplicity with the Genoese enemy.

Following your guided walking tour, walk back to the parking area and re-board the coach for the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking for approximately 2.6km (1.62 miles) with some steps to climb. It is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Tour includes an exterior visit of the Leaning Tower only. Along the way, the Savinis teach you how to recognise, select and cook truffles. In addition, learn all about the different varieties of truffles and the truffle-production cycle, including gathering, selection, cleaning, packaging, and more.

Lunch with Truffles

Following your truffle-hunting session, proceed for lunch back at the Savini Shop or Nacci Shop, then re-board your coach and commence the approximately one-hour drive back to the pier.

Bolgheri

Volterra

Tour of Pitigliano ("Little Jerusalem")

Drive 90 minutes to Pitigliano and enjoy the breathtaking first impression of Pitigliano, which almost appears to have grown naturally from its rocky foundations. Take a guided walking tour that includes the Jewish quarter, the Jewish museum and synagogue (excluding Saturdays). Alive with the presence of humans for 4,000 years, Pitigliano lies in the heart of the Etruscan region. Known also "Little Jerusalem," the village has been home for centuries (since Roman times) to a large Jewish community after their exile from the city of Rome.

There is free time to explore this place on your own, walking amidst the perfectly-preserved aqueducts and ancient buildings. If you have time, enjoy some of the "Bianco di Pitigliano" DOC wine made here, a straw-colored white wine with a delicate fragrance that is stored strictly in tufa cellars.

Traditional Lunch at Hostaria il Ceccottino (or Similar) in Pitigliano

With a short walk from the Jewish District, Hostaria il Ceccottino (or similar) awaits you for a delicious traditional 4-course lunch with wines.

Tour of Sovana and Scenic Drive

Next drive 30 minutes to a smaller Tufa city, Sovana, which is considered one of the most charming villages in Italy. Sovana dates back to the Etruscan times and through the centuries it has retained its importance as a Roman and medieval centre, hometown of Pope Gregory the VII. Prepare to be transported centuries back in time to Sovana, with its magical, ancient churches, including a cathedral built in the 11th century.

Enjoy free time to stroll and take photographs, and also take in the mystical, light-filled atmosphere of this picturesque place.

As your excursion concludes, make the return (2-hour) drive back to the Argentario port, with view of the quiet Orbetello lagoon and Argentario mountains by the sea.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking (1.5 miles) over uneven surfaces, inclines, and the use of stairs. Due to the terrain, this trip is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties or for those in a wheelchair. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable shoes, casual clothes, and to expect significant sun exposure. The Jewish Museum strictly prohibits photos and videos and while photography is not prohibited in the Synagogue, please be reminded it is a sacred place. PSF-H / Massa Marittima & Local Products Tasting

Discover the highlights of the awe-inspiring medieval town of Massa Marittima, including one of the most truly ancient cathedrals in the world, with elements dating back to the 12th or 13th century. Enjoy a guided tour of the village and cathedral and an incredible wine and olive oil tasting to experience the fruits of this rich region.

Drive 90 minutes from the pier to Massa Marittima and feel as though you have stepped into a Tuscan postcard in this northern part of the Maremma region. Resting on the hill and boasting elements that date back earlier than medieval times to the 10th century, the well-preserved architecture of Massa Marittima make it a must-see destination and an example of rare urban conservation in Tuscany.

Enjoy a walking tour of this city that rests above its surroundings at the top of a hill just few miles from the Tyrrhenian seashore. Walk the narrow streets to the Podestà Palace and the House of Municipality, which remind visitors of one of the most flourishing moments of its history. By the 14th century the town gained independence and wealth, to the extent that it minted its own coins. Massa Marittima's surrounding territory is rich in woods and metals, especially silver and copper, which gave origin to a flourishing Etruscan civilization, whose heritage is treasured in the archaeological museum.

The highlight of Massa Marittima is the Cathedral of San Cerbone, an impressive Romanesque-Gothic cathedral with elements dating back to the 12th and 13th centuries. See the many representations of animals that grace the windows and exterior of this impressive structure.

On your walking tour learn about the way in which the local community celebrates its three historical quarters; in May and August of each year, the flag waves and traditional costumes fill the streets in a parade commemorating San Bernardino da Siena, one of the Patron Saints of Massa Marittima born in 1380 who competed in the Balestro, the famous local contest of medieval games. In more recent times, the celebrations have evolved to include opera, photography and other artistic elements.

This village is also known for its remarkable and high-quality gourmet products including wine, honey, olive oil, cheese and delectable truffles. After your walking tour, enjoy a tasting of Tuscan red wine and exquisite extra-virgin olive oil.

Enjoy a scenic and relaxing drive (90 minutes) back to port.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking (1.25 miles), including stairs, paved, unpaved and cobbled surfaces, steep inclines. PSF-I / Wine Experience at Antinori "Le Mortelle" Winery with Lunch

Visit a Maremma winery that appears as if out of a dream, with rolling Tuscan hills and massive rows of aging wine barrels in its cellars. Your destination is Le Mortelle Winery run by Marchesi Antinori, of the Antinori family that has been engaged in the art of winemaking for over six centuries. In 1385, the owner's ancestor Giovanni di Piero Antiorini became a member of the Florentine Winemakers' Guild ("Arte Fiorentina dei Vinattieri").

On your one-hour drive, discover the stunning, picturesque Tuscan country roads that lead to some of the most prestigious wine estates in the region. Situated on a gentle, sloping terrain, the vineyard boasts 170 hectares (420 acres) of vines including Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon and several white grape varieties including Vermentino, Ansonica, and Viognier. The estate's sandy, loamy soil creates a unique flavor all its own that harkens one to this sunny, dry region of Italy.

As you arrive at La Mortelle vineyards, appreciate the scenic approach in the breathtaking rural Tuscan landscape. Receive a tour that discusses the way the estate was built; much of it is underground to minimize impact to the environment. Interestingly, the natural bedrock foundation provides temperature and humidity control that is completely natural and effective.

On your tour, taste one of Le Mortelle's white wines (Vermentino, Viognier, Ansonica) accompanied by home-baked focaccia bread and a seasonal fruit grown on the estate's land. Enjoy a guided tour of the wine cellar and learn about the process of wine production from start to finish.

Enjoy an exquisite three-course lunch paired with Le Mortelle red wines Botrosecco (made with Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc) and the Poggio alle Nane (Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carménère).

Have some free time to browse the local shop before returning to the ship after an idyllic day discovering the beauty and culture of a classic Tuscan vineyard.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for 1.25 miles (about 2 km), including stairs, paved, sloping, also uneven natural terrain. Spend the morning biking on an easy track brings you close to the Argentario nature and wildlife, thanks to its impressive location and to the lagoon acting as a safe haven for birds.

Begin your adventure directly at the pier, where your guide welcomes you for a short 15-minutes drive to Orbetello downtown by motor coach. Upon arrival at the bike Shop, choose your bike and helmet (different models available) before setting off on a scenic 2-hours guided ride through the pristine Feniglia Nature Reserve.

La Feniglia Nature Reserve, E-biking activity

This 18-kilometer route takes you along a sandbar covered by Mediterranean pine woods, flanked by the Orbetello Lagoon and the Tyrrhenian Sea. The path is flat and car-free, making it perfect for a relaxed ride surrounded by wildlife such as deer, foxes, wild boars, and a wide array of birds.

Orbetello Downtown, Gelato Tasting

After the ride, cycle 3 kilometers back to the bike shop in Orbetello. Once you have returned your equipment, enjoy a well-earned break with a complimentary tasting of artisan, gluten-free gelato. After this sweet break, enjoy some free time for a view on the salt lake or shopping in Orbetello village, before returning to your port city.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of activity including walking 500 metres and cycling for approximately 2 hours (11.8 miles \ 18 km). This tour is only suitable for in good physical conditions and is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. PSF-KA / Panoramic of Monte Argentario & Porto Ercole Walking Tour

Monte Argentario is situated in the south of Tuscany, and is the promontory considered the natural gateway to the Tuscan archipelago, with some close-by islands such as Giglio and Giannutri island, both part of the Tuscan Nature reserve.

Scenic Drive along the Argentario Coast, Porto Ercole Walking Tour

Board your coach for the 30-minute panoramic drive to Porto Ercole, a lovely seaside resort located on the south-east of the Argentario promontory.

Here, you will stop for a walking tour in the old village and fishermen's port. The first inhabitants of Porto Ercole were fishermen and still today, walking along the small port, one encounters old sea wolves intent on repairing fishing nets. You will take a walk in the heart of the village among alleys, squares overlooking the sea and stairways. You will walk along the promenade, where bars and restaurants with terraces overlooking the sea alternate with shops created from what once were fishermen's warehouses. You can still observe the construction sites dedicated to the repair work on the boats, and the landing of fish from the returning fishing boats.

Panoramic Drive, Convent of the Passionist Fathers

In addition to the natural charm of this region, you will have the opportunity to admire the imposing Spanish fortresses that were built in the 16th century: the Spanish fortress in Porto Santo Stefano and Forte Filippo in Porto Ercole. On the way back to the port, you will take a short detour to the convent of the Passionist Fathers, at the summit of Monte Argentario. At an altitude of 273 meters you will enjoy the splendid panorama that can be admired from the square onto the Orbetello lagoon and town. The convent is surrounded by generous vegetation and was built in the late 17th c. The Passionist Fathers live in community and lead a life of study, prayer and missionary activity. Many visitors stop by the Convent's shop to buy liquours or honey produced locally.

Drive back to Porto Santo Stefano.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of activity including walking for approximately 1.8 miles (about 2.9 km), few steps to negotiate to get on and off the bus and several during the walking tour over sometimes cobblestoned, unpaved and steep roads. Therefore the tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. We suggest wearing comfortable clothing and walking shoes as well as sun protection and Euro currency or credit cards for purchases from the ship. Proper attire is recommended if visiting the church at the Monastery of Friars.

PSF-L / A day at Argentario Golf Club

Spend a day at the five-star Argentario Golf Resort and Spa, nestled in the spectacular scenery and luxurious ambiance of Maremma, Tuscany. You can play in the 18-hole course surrounded by the nature in the scenic hills with a light lunch.

Golf (18 holes)

Play a round of golf in the rolling hills of the Argentario Resort, surrounded by vineyards, olive gardens, crystal-clear waters, and wild nature situated in a protected Mediterranean oasis where at times, while playing, it's not uncommon to spot foxes or fallow deer wandering across the course. This experience includes transfers, the Green Fee, and a light al fresco lunch served on the Club House restaurant terrace overlooking a beautiful lagoon. Golf equipment such as e-trolley, clubs, and buggy are not included in the package and are available upon request at an additional cost.

After your six-hour visit make the brief return drive to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal amount of activity unless a guest decides to golf, which involves a moderate amount of walking. There may be some stairs to negotiate and there is a short minibus ride to the Golf Hotel. The golf club is located inside the resort hotel at approx. 100 mts from lobby. There are a few steep inclines on the course. To guarantee a child seat, children's reservations must be made at least 24 hrs in advance. Children seats are mandatory for children under 79.4 lbs or 4'9". Space on this tour is limited; we suggest you book well in advance to avoid disappointment. The golf club has a limited stock of 10 rental bags (male/female \ right/left-handed). We kindly ask guests to specify at the time of booking whether they require a rental bag, and to indicate gender and handedness.

If non-golfing guests wish to accompany the golfers, they can enjoy a relaxing day by choosing either access to the outdoor pool with umbrella and sunbed, or access to the wellness spa. Both options include a light lunch at the hotel instead of the clubhouse, as arranged for the golfers. However, if preferred, they can still opt to have the light lunch at the clubhouse and wait for the golfers' return.

PSF-O / Hiking the Fortresses & Porto Ercole

Porto Ercole is known for its Spanish forts that were built during the Spanish domination and still characterize the unique landscape of the Argentario promontory.

Hike to Forte Filippo

Your hike will begin at the tender pier, with a short transfer to Porto Ercole. You will climb to Forte Filippo, a long winding road towards the top of the cliff, stopping for some lectures on the way. Once on top, you will be able to walk the entire perimeter of Forte Filippo walkway built for the soldiers who controlled the territory at the time. A large stretch of coast is visible - from the Feniglia strip of land - nowadays a nature reserve - to the southern coast of Tuscany. The premises of Forte Filippo are inhabited so the visit will only be external.

Spanish Fortress, Porto Ercole

The tour will then continue downhill to Porto Ercole and to the historic centre of Porto Ercole, follow your guide to the Spanish Rocca. See the imposing emblem of the State of the Presidios that dominates the main portal. Glance at the little islands and bays of the Argentario Southern coast and the exclusive villas perched on the cliff.

After your external visit, you will descend with your guide to the old Borgo with its noble palaces and the footprints of artist Caravaggio. Michelangelo Merisi, known as Caravaggio, reached Porto Ercole and actually died here so he is honored by the Town hall.

Scenic Drive

After this rather short and interesting tour, your guide will escort you to the coach for a scenic drive on the promontory. Drive along the Via Panoramica to Porto Santo Stefano and stop for some photo stops, last but not least the Fortress overlooking the port.

After this tour you will have the opportunity to return to the tender pier at your own pace, or stop by a restaurant or cafeteria while you walk back to the pier.

Please note: This hiking tour involves an extensive amount of activity including approximately 4.35 miles (about 7 km) of hiking at times over uneven surfaces and steep inclines, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and between 25 to 30 steps in the borgo. Limited time to rest during stops. This tour is only suitable for in good physical conditions. Therefore the tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. We suggest wearing comfortable clothing, hiking shoes, sun protection, sunglasses, hat and Euro currency or credit cards for purchases from the ship. Experience the medieval beauty and charm of Siena on-foot during this picturesque, full-day sightseeing tour.

Porto Santo Stefano, Siena, Skyline, Palaces, Towers, Landmarks

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately two-hour drive to Siena. Often described as the best-preserved medieval city in Italy, beautiful Siena is a medieval ensemble of palaces and towers cast in warm, pastel-colored bricks. The pride of the city is its skyline, which is dominated by the Gothic Cathedral and taut needle of the Torre del Mangia. However, the shell-shaped Piazza del Campo likely captures the most attention and fame, as it has been featured in films, photographs, and advertising campaigns.

City Centre, Contrade, Symbols on Banners and Walls of Buildings

Upon arrival in Siena, leave the coach for the approximately 0.5-mile (about 0.8-kilometre) walk to the city centre. Upon arrival, you may begin your guided walking tour or opt to explore the city at your leisure. Although it looks much as it did in the early-14th century, Siena is no museum. Its medieval Contrade, 17 neighborhoods into which the city has been historically divided, are a vibrant part of modern life. Along the way, you may see symbols of the Contrade; the turtle (tartuca), goose (oca), porcupine (istrice), and tower (torre) are emblazoned on banners and engraved on the walls of building.

San Domenico Church, Cathedral, Piazza del Campo, Free Time, Shopping, Maremma Region

The guided tour features a pleasant stroll through the medieval streets of Siena. Starting from San Domenico Church, walk to the Cathedral and iconic Piazza del Campo, where the famous Palio Horse Race takes place twice a year. Following the walking tour, ample time is made available for independent exploration, lunch and shopping. At the appointed time and place, meet your guide for the approximately 0.5-mile (about 0.8-kilometre) walk back to the coach. Your tour concludes with an approximately two-hour drive back to the pier via the well-preserved natural landscape of the lovely Maremma region.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately one mile (about 1.6 kilometres), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces and over inclines, uphill/downhill streets, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach. Walking in Siena is at the discretion of each guest. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility, guests who utilise a wheelchair, and guests prone to motion sickness. The driving time between the pier and Siena is approximately two hours in each direction. PSF-R / Porto Santo Stefano & Fortress on Foot

Discover the history, architecture, and charm of Porto Santo Stefano on-foot during this picturesque sightseeing excursion.

Porto Santo Stefano, Guided Walking Tour, Mount Argentario, Mediterranean Sea

Depart the pier for a guided walking tour of the port village of Porto Santo Stefano, the main town on the north-western promontory of Mount Argentario and only one of the three ports on the peninsula. Mount Argentario is a wooded mountain overlooking the blue Mediterranean Sea, a promontory infused with nature, history, and human activities. Porto Santo Stefano has four quarters, in Italian Rioni: Croce, Fortezza, Pilarella, and Valle. Various bays of Porto Santo Stefano enable yachts and sailing vessels to operate throughout the year; these same bays were ideal hideouts for pirate incursions of a bygone era.

Downtown Area, Old Town, Monuments, Four Quarters

Whilst strolling along the narrow, winding streets of Porto Santo Stefano to the downtown area, learn about the history of this old fishing village built on 'rock', which developed into a tourist destination famous throughout the Mediterranean. The village of Porto Santo Stefano has four quarters, in Italian Rione: Croce, Fortezza, Pilarella, and Valle. Walk to the small port, where fishing boats and yachts wait to sail again. The municipality is here, in the centre of the Old Town, which had developed around a watch tower offering protection to its inhabitants since the 15th century, now the imposing Spanish Fortress.

Spanish Fortress, Saint Stephen Parish Church, Artisan Tools, Gelato Stop

Discover the historic Spanish Fortress, which was built during the Spanish Presidios and offers a breath-taking panoramic view of Porto Santo Stefano; visit the small museum displaying artisan tools that were utilized to craft the boats of the day. Leaving the Spanish Fortress, climb down to the Parish Church dedicated to Saint Stephen, in Rione Croce. Its Latin inscription, 'Portvm Salvts Indulgeat', pleads the Patron Saint to grant a safe port to sailors. Afterward, A final stop is made for a creamy and refreshing gelato. At the conclusion of your tour, commence the short walk back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.55 miles (about 2.5 kilometres), including approximately 70 steps to climb the village to the fortress, at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces and inclines, with 30 additional steep steps to negotiate at reachand inside the Spanish Fortress. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection, bottled water, and Euro currency or credit cards for purchases from the ship. Guests must be at least 6 years old to participate on this tour; minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over 18 years old. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Operation of this tour is subject to weather conditions. The tour sequence may vary.

PSF-S / Easy Panoramic of Monte Argentario & Orbetello

Monte Argetario is situated in the south of Tuscany, and is the promontory considered the natural gateway to the Tuscan archipelago, with some close-by islands such as Giglio and Giannutri island, both part of the Tuscan Nature reserve. This tour shows the best locations in the most comfortable way.

Panoramic Drive, Convent of the Passionist Fathers (outside only)

Board your coach for the 30-minute panoramic drive to the convent of the Passionist Fathers, at the summit of Monte Argentario. At an altitude of 273 meters you will enjoy the splendid panorama that can be admired from the square onto the Orbetello lagoon and town. The convent is surrounded by generous vegetation and was built in the late 17th c. The Passionist Fathers live in community and lead a life of study, prayer and missionary activity. Many visitors stop by the Convent's shop to buy liquours or honey produced locally.

Orbetello Village, Optional Walking Tour (flat), Free Time

After the scenic view resume your drive to Orbetello. The first inhabitants of Orbetello were fishermen and still today, walking along the lagoon, one encounters traces of the fishing activity, such as the headquarters of the Slow Food presidia \ I Pescatori di Orbetello. You will take a walk in the heart of the village to see the Cathedral, the main squares and small alleys leading to the Eastern or Western lagoon. You will walk along the corso, where you will enjoy some time at leisure to explore more on your own or indulge in a Gelato or cappuccino.

Scenic Drive

During your scenic drive in addition to the natural charm of this region, you will have the opportunity to admire the imposing Spanish fortresses that were built in the 16th century on the Argentario monastery: the Spanish fortress in Porto Santo Stefano and Forte Filippo in Porto Ercole. On the way back to the port, you will take a short detour on Via Panoramica, a coastal road that shows two of the Tuscan archipel islands: Giglio and Giannutri islands, both part of the National Park of the Tuscan isles.

Please note: This tour involves a little to moderate amount of activity including walking of 900 metres with few steps to negotiate to get on and off the bus over sometimes cobblestoned surfaces in Orbetello. Walking in Orbetello is at guest's discretion and it is on flat surface. Once in Orbetello, guests can choose if following the guide for short walking tour or just enjoying time at leisure. Therefore the tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a foldable wheelchair, able to negotiate steps on the bus. We suggest wearing comfortable clothing and walking shoes as well as sun protection and Euro currency or credit cards for purchases from the ship. Proper attire is recommended if visiting churches. Guests are kindly advised that access to the convent is via a narrow road, and the approach may be at a reduced speed for comfort and safety.

AJA-A / Highlights of Ajaccio

Drive along the lively Cours Napoléon, continue through the former English Quarter and Austerlitz Square, home to another tribute to Napoleon, a replica of the famous statue at Les Invalides in Paris.

Sanguinaires Islands Viewpoint

Leaving the city behind, your coach follows the scenic Route des Sanguinaires towards the northern tip of the gulf. Along the way, take in a series of idyllic sandy beaches and charming seaside developments. Ajaccio Old Town and Cathedral

Along the way, explore the cluster of ancient streets spreading north and south of Place Foch, which opens on the seafront. On the square, see a statue of Napoleon dressed as a Roman Consul and surrounded by four lions. Next, pass by the Cathedral, completed in 1593 and dedicated to the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Cathedral is remarkable for its modest dimensions, imposing dome and fine ochre facade that lend a unique charm to the building. Napoleon was christened here in 1771.

Maison Bonaparte

Your tour continues with a stroll along Rue St. Charles en route to Maison Bonaparte, Napoleon's birthplace, located right in the town centre. This landmark is an example of how an insular leading figure's house looked like in the 18th century. Now a four-storey home, it has been enlarged and refurbished several times in its history. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the house, which is narrow but filled with Bonaparte's possessions.

Place du Diamant, Rue Fesch

On the Place du Diamant, also known as 'Place de Gaulle', see a statue of Napoleon on horseback surrounded by his four brothers and facing the town.
