Civitavecchia (Rome), Italy | Embark, Depart 7:00 pm

Day 1 | Saturday, June 6, 2026 (Docked)

Our **luxury yacht cruise** starts in the port of **Civitavecchia**, **gateway to the 'Eternal City' of Rome**. Upon arrival, you'll be transferred to the **all-inclusive**, **100-guest** *Emerald Sakara* to begin our journey along Italy and Corsica's breathtaking coastlines. **Embarkation begins at 2:00 pm**.

Amalfi, Italy | 1:00 pm – 10:00 pm

Day 2 | Sunday, June 7, 2026 (Anchor / Tender)

Amalfi and Ravello

Cost: Included

2:00 pm - 6:30 pm | 4 hours and 30 minutes

Activity Level: Easy – Moderate (uneven ground and steps at Villa Rufolo)

Travel to the hilltop town of Ravello, high above the Amalfi Coast. Begin your exploration with a visit to **Villa Rufolo**, a monumental complex that dates back to the 13th century. Admire the iconic tower and the Moorish-influenced architecture that has captured the imaginations of visitors for centuries. The highlight of the visit is the **splendid garden of Villa Rufolo**, a haven of blooming flowers, lush greenery, and breathtaking views that stretch beyond the mountains. Enjoy free time in Ravello to wander the alleys that inspired literary greats like D.H. Lawrence and Virginia Woolf.

Return to Amalfi for a leisurely walk through the **charming streets of Amalfi**. Wander past colorful storefronts, historic piazzas and picturesque alleys that reveal the town's rich history and vibrant culture.

Return to the ship via tender.

Capri, Italy | 6:00 am – 10:00 pm

Day 3 | Monday, June 8, 2026 (Anchor / Tender)

Capri from the Sea Cost: Included

9:30 am - 12:30 pm | 3 hours

Activity Level: Easy

After tendering ashore, board a traditional wooden boat for a **two-hour scenic tour of Capri's striking coastline**. Explore its grottoes, gorges, and rocky formations, home to about 850 plant species, including



ancient Roman villa plants like Tarantine Myrtle and Acanthus. The island is renowned for its citrus groves, olive trees, and vine-covered terraces carved into the island's slopes.

During your cruise, you will have the opportunity to **swim in the beautiful turquoise waters** (it is recommended to wear swimwear under your clothing).

Return to the harbor to explore Capri at your leisure or return to the ship by tender.

Capri Highlights by Private Cabriolet Taxi

Cost: \$219 per person

9:30 am - 1:30 pm | 4 hours and 30 minutes

Activity Level: Easy – Moderate (uneven ground and downhill/uphill in Capri)

Begin your adventure with a ride in one of **Capri's iconic open-air cabriolet taxis** to the picturesque **village of Anacapri**. Here, choose between two unique experiences: soar above the island on a scenic chairlift ride to Monte Solaro for sweeping views of the Bay of Naples, or join your guide for an enriching visit to the historic Axel Munthe's Villa.

After some leisure time, re-board your taxi and head to **Capri Town** to visit the heart of the island, including the famous "Piazzetta," the stylish Via Camerelle, and the town's elegant shopping district. Enjoy a relaxing refreshment break at a local bar before walking back to the taxi pick-up point for your return to the pier.

Alternatively, you may choose to remain in Capri Town and return to the ship independently at your leisure.

Ride an open-air taxi to Anacapri, where you can take a chairlift to Monte Solaro or visit Axel Munthe's Villa. After free time, continue to Capri Town to explore the Piazzetta, Via Camerelle and chic shops. Enjoy a refreshment before returning to the pier.

Sorrento, Italy | 6:00 am - 10:00 pm

Day 4 | Tuesday, June 9, 2026 (Anchor / Tender)

Guided Tour of Pompeii Cost: \$159 per person

8:00 am - 1:30 pm | 5 hours and 30 minutes

Activity Level: Moderate (uneven ground and cobblestones)

Step back in time and explore the captivating ruins of **Pompeii**, frozen in history by the eruption of **Mount Vesuvius** in 79 A.D. This archaeological site showcases the resilience of an ancient Roman town, waiting to be rediscovered.

After tendering ashore, board the local shuttle to the uptown meeting point, board a motorcoach for a 45–60-minute drive to the fascinating world of Pompeii. Enjoy a **walking tour** to explore the world's finest example of an ancient Roman town as your guide will unravel the historical events, tragic stories, and daily life of the city's 20,000 inhabitants. Marvel at well-preserved frescoes, splendid mosaics, and original marble decorations that provide a glimpse into the opulence of a bygone era.

Enjoy a soft drink and a slice of Neapolitan pizza before returning to Sorrento, with options to return directly to the ship or explore picturesque Sorrento on your own.



Ponza, Italy | 8:00 am - 3:00 pm

Day 5 | Wednesday, June 10, 2026 (Anchor / Tender)

No shore excursions offered today.

The highlight of the day is the **Emerald Marina Watersports Platform**. Swim in the turquoise **Tyrrhenian Sea** and enjoy the use of stand-up paddleboards, kayaks, snorkeling gear, SEABOBS, a water trampoline and floating mats.

Porto Cervo, Italy | 8:00 am - 10:00 pm

Day 6 | Thursday, June 11, 2026 (Anchor / Tender)

Villages of Sardinia and Coddu Vecchiu Giant's Tomb

Cost: \$139 per person 9:00 am - 1:00 pm | 4 hours

Activity Level: Moderate (cobblestones/10-minute walk to coach parking lot)

Visit San Pantaleo, a charming village set among dramatic granite peaks, then explore Coddu Vecchiu, home to the Giant's Tomb, an impressive Nuragic Bronze Age monument. Continue to Baja Sardinia to enjoy stunning views and a relaxing atmosphere before returning to Porto Cervo.

Drive to the **charming village of San Pantaleo** for a brief stop to admire its impressive granite peaks sculptured by the winds. Continue to the **Coddu Vecchiu Archaeological site**, home to the Giant's Tomb, a significant example of Nuragic funerary architecture. This well-preserved collective tomb served individuals from the nearby **Nuragic Village of La Prisgiona** during the Bronze Age. Explore its two-phase construction, featuring a semicircular ceremonial area with a large arched stele of profound sacral significance.

Afterward, visit **Baja Sardinia**, a delightful summer village offering a serene atmosphere and breathtaking views of the Archipelago. Enjoy free time to relax and soak in the beauty of the surroundings. Return to the Porto Cervo parking lot for a leisurely downhill walk back to the tender or explore the marina on your own.

Panoramic Tour and Visit to La Maddalena

Cost: \$209 per person 8:30 am – 1:30 pm | 5 hours

Activity Level: Moderate (cobblestones/10-minute walk to coach parking lot)

Depart from Porto Cervo to **Palau**, passing through the charming villages of San Pantaleo and Arzachena. In Palau, board a **public ferry to La Maddalena Island** and enjoy panoramic views of Sardinia's coastline. Stop at Guardia Vecchia for stunning vistas of the Maddalena Archipelago and Corsica. Upon reaching Maddalena, enjoy a walking tour in the town center, including Garibaldi Square, known as Red Square for its unique red paving, followed by free time.

Return by public ferry to Palau and continue to drive back to Porto Cervo parking lot for a leisurely downhill walk back to the tender or explore the marina on your own.



Bonifacio, Corsica, France | 7:00 am – 4:00 pm

Day 7 | Friday, June 12, 2026 (Anchor / Tender)

Highlights of Bonifacio (With Tasting)

Cost: Included

9:30 am - 1:00 pm | 3 hours and 30 minutes

Activity Level: Moderate (paved surfaces and cobblestones)

Begin your Bonifacio exploration with a **mini train ride** through the Bosco quarter, featuring St. Francis convent and a fascinating mariners' cemetery. Enjoy panoramic views of Sardinia and pass the Corsican Gothic St. Dominique church, likely built by the Templars in 1270. Continue on a **walking tour** through narrow streets with granite houses, visiting the 14th-century St. Marie Majeure church. Discover Two Emperors Street, Place des Armes, and Jardins des Vestiges.

Enjoy **Corsican wine at a local bar and taste a few of the local specialties**. Choose to take the mini train back to the ship or explore independently.

Hike Perusato Cost: Included

8:00 am - 11:00 am | 3 hours Activity Level: Active - Strenuous

Hike from Bonifacio's marina up the **Montée Rostello** to reach **St Roch Chapel**, offering stunning views over the port. Continue to the **cliffs of Bonifacio**. Traverse the protected nature site, following the rugged limestone cliffs south-eastward toward Capo Pertusato. Along the way, you'll pass by the Semaphore, a naval observation tower that oversees the bustling shipping traffic of the Straits. Enjoy breathtaking views of Sardinia, the Lavezzi and Cavallo islands, and the **picturesque citadel of Bonifacio** perched atop the cliffs.

After taking in the sights, return along the same route to the ship or remain in town to explore independently.

Coastal Boat Trip
Cost: \$89 per person

1:15 pm – 2:30 pm | 1 hour and 15 minutes

Activity Level: Moderate

From the pier, embark on a 60-minute **coastal exploration** through the scenic channel between Bonifacio's cliffs, passing the historic "Madonetta" lighthouse from 1854. Marvel at the "Little Dragon" marine cave and its natural skylight. Glide past "Fazio Creek" and spot landmarks like the "Rudder of Corsica" rock and the legendary King of Aragon's staircase, carved to transport water. The excursion culminates at the "Grain of Sand" rock, a striking 10-meter formation, ideal for memorable photos.

Civitavecchia (Rome), Italy | Arrive 8:00 am, Disembark

Day 8 | Saturday, June 13, 2026 (Docked)
